Traffic Light Warning Scale

Before each outdoor session, the committee will rate the risk of outdoor shooting using the following scale. A session may be cancelled at the last minute (or during the session) with appropriate weather warnings to prevent potential injury or damage to equipment.

Archers shooting personal equipment outdoors do so at their own risk. Whilst the club will minimise the potential for damage, the club cannot accept liability for damage to personal property.
